

## Some Developmental Milestones

Does your child:

**By 3 months:**

- ◆ Push up on their arms and hold their head up?
- ◆ Follow a moving toy with his eyes?
- ◆ Startle by a loud noise?

**By 6 months:**

- ◆ Reach for objects?
- ◆ Babble when alone?
- ◆ Sit up with light support?

**By 9 months:**

- ◆ Imitate sounds such as mama and bye-bye?
- ◆ Sit without support?
- ◆ Crawl (up on hands and knees)?

**By 12 months:**

- ◆ Finger-feed self solid foods?
- ◆ Pull up to a standing position?

**By 18 months:**

- ◆ Name some objects?
- ◆ Walk well and run?

**By 24 months:**

- ◆ Stack 2-4 objects?
- ◆ Use 2-3 words sentences?
- Walk up and down stairs?

### When Should a child be referred to Child Find?

- ◆ When birth complications or a medical disorder interferes with developmental growth and/or learning
- ◆ When you or someone else not living in the home does not understand the child's speech
- ◆ When there is a noticeable delay in the child's learning pattern compared to other children that is the same age
- ◆ When hearing and vision appears to be difficult
- ◆ When the child struggle with social or emotional difficulties that affect his/her ability to learn
- ◆ When the child seems to have difficulty understanding simple directions

### Who may refer children?

Children may be referred by any of the following:

- ◆ Parents/legal guardians
- ◆ Other family members
- ◆ Physicians
- ◆ Child care providers
- ◆ Community agencies
- ◆ Infants & Toddlers Program
- ◆ Any other concerned individual

## What is Early Intervention?

- ◆ Early intervention brings your family and professionals together, working to support your child's growth, development, and learning.
- ◆ Early intervention builds upon your child and family's strengths.
- ◆ Early intervention focuses on enhancing your child's participation in family routines and community life.

## What Steps are Taken at Child Find?

### Step 1:

#### Referral/Screening

Parents provide written consent if assessment is considered. Once a child is referred, a screening will take place immediately, and the results will be shared with the parents/guardians.

### Step 2:

#### Qualifications determined by AZEIP or School placement

The Arizona Early Intervention Program will determine if the child qualifies. If the child does qualify, a comprehensive assessment will be set up in the family's home. If the child is over 3 years of age the school will determine if the child qualifies for services.

### Step 3:

#### IEP/IFSP Meeting

Assessment is completed. An IEP meeting is then set up to review the results and determine eligibility for services.



## How the program will benefit you and your family?

- ◆ Referrals are received from parents/guardians, doctors, social services, or other community programs.
- ◆ Home visits by a Child Find Parent Educator are provided to families to determine needs.
- ◆ Free developmental screening is provided by the assigned Child Find Parent Educator in the following 5 areas: thinking, moving, socializing, and self help skills.
- ◆ Complete evaluation/assessment is conducted by a contracted agency.
- ◆ Eligibility is determined.
- ◆ Development of an IEP (Individual Education Plan) or IFSP (Individual Family Service Plan) is based on eligibility.
- ◆ Services provided in natural environment.
- ◆ Monthly Parent meetings.
- ◆ Health fairs throughout the year.
- ◆ Trainings.
- ◆ Resource Library.
