English= 4 credits (*one must include research paper writing & American Literature)

Math= 4 credits (Algebra and beyond)

Science= 3 credits lab sciences

World Languages= 2 credits (same language)

Fine Art=1 credit

Social Studies=2 credits

Electives=4 credits
