REMEMBERING THE BASICS OF BEING SAFE

Here are some basic tips on how to stay safe. Just try to remember **CAW**:

Cover your mouth and nose. It is very important that we remember to cover our face, especially when we have to run to the store and have to leave our homes. You can cover your face by wearing a face mask or a face covering. It might not be a good idea to wear one face mask for months, so remember to replace them.

Avoid Crowds. When you are out at a store, the mall or even a restaurant, remember to distance yourself. The common distance is 6 feet or about 2 arms' length. You never know who can be sick and it is just better to be safe.

Wash your hands. I remember my mother, as a child always telling me to wash my hands when I came in from playing outside. Sometimes we may not have our parents around to tell us so we have to remember to wash our hands with soap and water.
